Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in
The Greenville News

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the
authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of
