Lewis M. Jennings and Mary T. Jennings, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the south side of Douglass Drive, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 31 on plat of Country Club Estates made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1926, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", at page 190 and 191, and having, according to said plat the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Douglass Drive, joint front corner of Lots 30 and 31, said pin also being 200 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of Douglass Drive and Ridge Drive, and running thence with the line of Lot 30, S. 23-22 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot 60, S. 66-38 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 32, N. 23-22 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Douglass Drive; thence with the south side of Douglass Drive N. 66-38 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
