Clistrap his heirs and assigns all the timber of every kind and of the size bereinafter specified, upon all these certain tracts of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, as follows:

One tract of F. A. Austin to Woday M. Austin containing \$1.40 acres, more or less and more fully described in deed of the said F. A. Austin to Woday M. Austin June 10, 1940.

Also, tract of F. A. Austin to Weday M. Austin centaining 90.40 acres, more or less and convoyed by the said F. A. Austin to Weday M. Austin June 10, 1940. Both of said deeds being not yet recorded.

Also, two tracts of Wm. F. Smith to F. A. Austin, one containing 52 acres and the other containing 52 acres, which are fully described in deed of Wm. F. Smith to F. A. Austin.

Also, tract of five sores which was conveyed to Mrs. J. C. Burdotte to F. A. Austin on the 17th. day of December, 1898, See deed recorded in Dood Book, Vol. 000 at page 30.
