WHEREAS, The Carolina Loan &amp; Trust Company, a corporation

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 19th day of July, 1941, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by R. NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, R. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-six Hundred (\$2600.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said W. R. Steele

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. R. Steele

"All that tract or parcel of land, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: Lots one and two (1 and 2) according to a plat recorded in Plat Book D, page 22, R. M. O., Office for said Greenville County, being the same lots conveyed to Mary M. Calhoun by D. A. Lykes by deed dated July 28, 1919, and recorded in Volume 43, page 572, said lots having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning on the northeast corner of Jenkins and Calhoun Streets; thence with Calhoun St. N. 15-3/4 E. 120 feet to corner of Lot No. 3; thence S. 75 E. 102 feet with line of Lot No. 3; thence S. 15-3/4 W. 120 feet to Jenkins St.; thence with Jenkins Street N. 75 W. 102 feet to the beginning corner."

"Also, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: In the City of Greenville, being the western half of Lot No. 2 according to a plat recorded in Plat Book or in Deed Book HHH, page 042, and described in the deed from Dan Richardson to Mary M. Calhoun, and G. L. Calhoun, who subsequently conveyed to Mary M. Calhoun his interest therein, see deeds recorded in Deed Books VVV, page 398, and 16, page 127, respectively; said lot has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
