WHEREAS, W. D. McClary, L. E. Brailsford and A. J. Flowden, Summerton, S. C.

did on the 7th day of September, 1934, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Summerton Depository.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Summerton, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is  
A general cash depository business as authorized in the Act of March 13, 1934.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty-five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars,  
payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Twenty-five (25) Dollars,  
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of September, 1934,  
at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors:  
W. D. McClary, L. E. Brailsford, A. J. Flowden, W. H. Anderson and I. Dumas.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President L. E. Brailsford  
as Vice-President, A. J. Flowden; as Secretary, Cashier, Charles N. Flowden.

NINTH: That all requirements of the Acts approved April 4, 1932 and March 13, 1933  
100 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 100  
per cent, of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the  
Cashier and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in  
The Manning Times  
a newspaper published in the County of Clarendon.

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their Charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
