WHEREAS, George Norwood and W. W. Pate, of  
Greenville, S. C.,

did on the 1st day of February, 1941, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Convenience, Inc.,

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to manufacture surgical bandages, pads, absorbent cotton, and other similar products; to complete sewing operations on contract; to buy and sell materials raw and finished used in such processes; to sterilize various finished products and to sterilize various packages on contract; to buy and sell real estate; to borrow money and to engage generally in any and all business necessarily incident thereto.

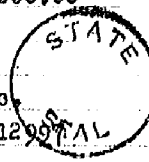
Charter Amended Aug. 29, 1941.

by Providing that the capital stock share be and is hereby divided into 20000 shares of the par value of \$5.00 and 20,000 shares without per value but with a stated value of \$30,000.00 August 29, 1941.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Hundred Thirty Thousand (\$130,000.00)

payable Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars paid in; Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) subscribed; and Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) Dollars not subscribed.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is two hundred and fifty (250)

of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) five hundred (500) shares no par value common; and two hundred and fifty (250) shares of no par value preferred common.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 31st day of January, 1941, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors:

W. W. Pate; George Norwood; W. D. Young; Arthur C. Kingston; R. C. McCall.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President George Norwood Executive as Vice-President, W. D. Young as Secretary, R. C. McCall as Treasurer, George Norwood.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Means Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
