THIRD: That the principal place of business is 16 East Washington St., Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is wholesale and retail fruit and produce business.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00)

payable paid in full.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ten (10) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)

SEVENTH: That after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of September, 1941, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: J. J. Francis and George A. Francis

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President J. J. Francis as Vice-President, George A. Francis as Secretary, George A. Francis as Treasurer, J. J. Francis.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville News

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
