to the undersigned owner(s) paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grant(s), bargain(s), sell(s), convey(s) and warrant(s) to PLANTATION PIPE LINE COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way and easement for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating, altering, repairing, removing, changing the size of, and replacing pipe for the transportation as a common carrier for hire of oil, crude petroleum and refined petroleum products or combinations thereof or similar thereto, natural and artificial gas, casinghead and natural gasoline and any other liquids or gases, the Grantee to have the right to select the route, under, upon, over and through the lands situate in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, described as follows:

McKelvey, containing 11 acres, more or less: BEGINNING on a stone on road with W. A. McKelvey and George W. King, thence N. 87 1/2 W. 12.20 to a stone; thence S. 9 E. to a stone; thence N. 72 E. 5.50 to a stone; thence N. 43 1/2 E. 2.00 to a pine; thence N. 9 1/2 E. 15.10 to a stone, the beginning, and being the same conveyed to Mouday Morton Sept. 29, 1885. Also that other piece, parcel or tract of land situate, being and lying in the County and State aforesaid adjoining the above described lands; BEGINNING on a stone at branch and running thence N. 83 W. 4.00 to a stone; thence S. 54 1/2 W. 10.37 to a stone; thence S. 9 1/2 W. 15.10 to a pine; thence S. 43 1/2 W. 2.00 to a stone; thence S. 53 1/2 E. 16.25 to a stone; thence S. 83 E. 16.66 to a stone on east side of branch; thence N. 7 W. 5.94 to persimon; thence N. 38 1/2 W. 4.00 to a spring; thence N. 15 E. 2.75 to stone; thence N. 42 W. 5.00 to the beginning 78-1/3 acres, more or less, and being the same conveyed to Mouday Morton by W. A. McKelvey, Ded. 9, 1896.
