(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Ida Heatherly, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the North side of Paris Mountain Road, in the Subdivision known as North Sunset Hills, and being known and designated as Lot No. 10 of said Subdivision according to Plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, in July, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 92, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Paris Mountain Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 11, N. 28-37 W. 164.4 feet to an iron pin on a 5 foot alley reserved for utilities; thence with said alley S. 64-57 W. 70.8 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Central Court; thence with the East side of Central Court S. 33-32 E. 144.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the corner of Central Court and Paris Mountain Avenue S. 76-16 E. 36.7 feet to the beginning corner. Together with a one-half interest in so much of the 5 foot alley reserved for utilities as bounds upon the above described lot on the rear.

This is part of the land conveyed by Riverside Land Company to Knox L. Haynsworth, as Trustee, by deed dated June 9th, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 234, at page 121.

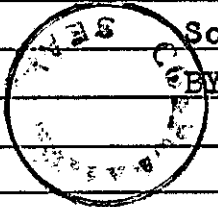

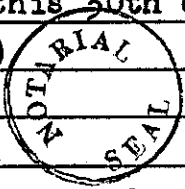
