"All that certain tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and containing 15 1/4 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by a survey made by W. P. Morrow on November 5, 1941, to-wit:

Beginning on a stake in the Branch, the Few line, thence S. 61 1/2 W. 13 1/4 feet to the church corner; thence N. 39-3/4 W. 25 1/4 feet to a large Black gum; thence S. 71 W. 222 feet to a point in the Oneal road; thence up said road N. 17 1/2 W. 25 feet to a point of intersection with the Pennington road; thence with said road N. 30 E. 295 feet to a point in said road; thence N. 42 E. 218.5 feet to a point; N. 63 1/2 E. 122.5 feet to a point; thence N. 76 1/2 E. 425.5 feet to a point; thence N. 37 1/2 E. 346 feet to a point; thence N. 55-3/4 E. 195.5 ft. to a point on the bridge the center of the branch; thence down said branch as the line S. 35 1/2 E. 100 feet to a bend; thence S. 25 1/2 E. 117 feet to a bend; thence S. 4 E. 9 1/4 feet to a bend; thence S. 35 1/2 E. 205 feet to a bend; thence S. 4 E. 95 feet to a stake in the branch, the beginning corner.

The above land is a part of the land that the grantor and Sallie J. Wilson and Nancy W. Roe inherited from their mother, Mrs. Jane D. Wilson and subsequently whereto the said Sallie J. Wilson and Nancy W. Roe conveyed their interest therein to the grantor herein. This is a part of the tract of land known as the Few Place."
