Beginning at an iron pin on Cemetery Street, in the town of Fountain Inn, running thence S. 32.15 E. 99.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54 W. 32.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36.30 E. 90.2 feet to an iron pin, in or near unnamed street; thence across unnamed street 20 feet to R. A. Jones Estate line; thence along Jones Estate line N. 53.30 E. 25.6 feet to a stake; corner of garden of the R. A. Jones Estate; thence N. 53.30 E. 21.90 to a stake, Fountain Inn School property; thence with School property line N. 26.50 W. 206.7 feet to a stake on Cemetery Street; thence along said street S. 62.30 W. 45.7 feet to point of beginning, and containing twenty-four one hundredths of one acre according to a plat made by W.
