(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Paul Olen White, his heirs and assigns:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the South side of Fifth Street, in Section No. 6 of Judson Mills Village, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 98 as shown on a plat of Section No. 6 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1941, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 106 and 107, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Fifth Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 98 and 99, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 99, S. 1-40 E. 69.5 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 99, corner of Lot No. 102; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 102, S. 88-11 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots No. 98, 97, 102 and 103; thence with the line of Lot No. 97, N. 1-40 W. 69.5 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Fifth Street; thence with the South side of Fifth Street N. 88-11 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to me by Judson Mills by deed dated December 1, 1941, and to be recorded, and this conveyance is subject to all the reservations and restrictions contained in said deed.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay that certain note and mortgage given by me to Judson Mills to secure a portion of the purchase price of the above described premises, which said note and mortgage are both dated December 1, 1941, and are in the principal sum of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars, which said mortgage is to be recorded.
