I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Mary Gallamore

on or about the 16th day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Eugene W. Gallamore, and Mary Gallamore as Committee for Eugene W. Gallamore,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 13th day of December, 1941, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. T. Martin

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$250.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said W. T. Martin

" All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just without the City of Greenville, in Park Place, being known as Lot No. 8 in Block G, Park Place, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 119, having a frontage of 50 feet on Second Avenue, with a depth of 150 feet, being one of the lots conveyed to R. N. Gallamore by Margaret Arnold Belcher, Executrix of James Lilly, deceased, by deed dated August 10, 1925, and recorded in Book 105, Page 417."
