All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the Northeast side of Edgewood Avenue just off Paris Mountain Road, being known designated as Lot No. 36 on plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1938, of "Leawood" Property of C. M. Gaffney, Trustee, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J" at Pages 18 and 19, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Edgewood Avenue which point is 152 feet east of the intersection of Edgewood Avenue and Forest Lane and running thence N. 33-54 E. 166.8 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lot No. 50; thence S. 55-41 E. 77 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 33-54 W. 167.4 feet to an iron pin on Edgewood Avenue; thence with Edgewood Avenue N. 55-18 W. 77 feet to the point of beginning.
