KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Judson Mills

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Seventy-five and no/100 (\$975.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto James Harold Smith, his Heirs

and Assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of E Street, in Section No. 6 of Judson Mills Village, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 25 as shown on a plat of Section No. 6 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1941, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 106 and 107, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of E Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 24 and 25, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24, N. 88-23 E. 325.7 feet to an iron pin on or near the West bank of Brushy Creek; thence continuing with the line of Lot No. 24, N. 88-23 E. to a point in the center of Brushy Creek; thence down Brushy Creek approximately S. 39-49 E. 89.2 feet to a point joint rear corner of Lots No. 25 and 108; thence with the line of Lot No. 108, S. 88-23 W. to an iron pin on or near the West bank of Brushy Creek; thence continuing with the line of Lot No. 108 and with the lines of Lots No. 107, 106, and 26, S. 88-23 W. 381 feet to an iron pin on the East side of E Street; thence with the East side of E Street, N. 1-37 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
