I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, W. B. Lynn and E. R. Lynn in their own right and as Executors of the last will of John C. Lynn

on or about the 19th day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-one exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Mary L. Styles, Inez L. Brookshire, B. D. Thompson, John H. Thompson, Vera T. Bagwell, Billie Thompson, W. C. Thompson and J. F. Lynn

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th day of January, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to E. R. Lynn

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-9077)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$222.22

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said E. R. Lynn.

All the right, title and interest of the Minor Defendants, Billie Thompson and W. C. Thompson, the same being an undivided two thirty-sixth (2/36) interest in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain tract and parcel of land situate, lying, and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northeast side of the road leading from Greer to Hendersonville and known as the Buncombe Road, and containing fifty-six acres, more or less, bounded on the West by lands of James Plumley and Willis, on the North east by lands of Walter Crain, on the southeast by lands of B. D. Thompson, and J. A. Fowler, and on the southwest by the said Buncombe Road, and being the same land conveyed to John C. Lynn by Redmond L. Andrea by deed recorded in Book XX, at page 589, and containing fifty-one acres, and a tract conveyed by J. C. Lynn and T. E. Lynn as Executors to John C. Lynn by deed dated March 5, 1909, and recorded in Vol. 4, at page 85."
