TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Miles Crain, as Administrator of the Estate of Lula L. Dill, Deceased, Ruthel Dill Crain, and Joe P. Dill, Individually and as Administrator of the Estate of Lula L. Dill,

on or about the 18th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Forty-One exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Frank Dill, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th day of April, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Lloyd Poole

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$750.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Lloyd Poole

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, North of the Village of O'Neal, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 2.2 acres, more or less, according to survey by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the road, and running thence S. 69 1/2 E. 1.95 chains to a stake; thence N. 45 1/2 E. 7.85 chains to a point in the Saluda Gap Road; thence N. 40 W. 3.48 chains to a point in said road; thence S. 34 1/2 W. 9.10 chains to a stake, the beginning corner."
