decree, and upon receipt of \$105.31

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said

T. D. Riddle all the right, title and interest of Jean Gresham in and to the following  
described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing 161.50 acres, more or less,  
located, lying and being in Austin and Butler Townships, County of Greenville, State of South  
Carolina, and bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to the following: On the North Mrs. Sarah  
Vaughan, B. L. Smith, and Arthur Henderson, on the East T. T. Fowler, on the South J. W. Brown and  
Nancy Vaughan, on the West T. E. Pike, W. M. Pike and Jim Pike. The land has such shapes, metes,  
courses and distances as do fully appear in a Plat thereof made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in 1927.  
The said plat was filed with the First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank of Columbia and is now in  
the possession of the Federal Land Bank of Columbia. Reference is hereto made to that plat for a  
more definite and particular description of the said lands."
