about three miles north west from Oneal, lying on the north side of Few's Bridge Road, being bounded on the North and East by other lands of myself, on the south by the Few's Bridge Road, and on the west by lands of Walter Rollins, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from I. F. Reese, Oct. 9th, 1918, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 50 at page 160, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin in the Few's Bridge Road, joint corner with Walter Rollins, and runs thence with the Rollins line N. 34-15 W. 224 feet to an iron pin on said line; thence a new line N. 77-45 E. 208.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-15 E. 224 feet to a point in center of Few's Bridge Road (iron pin back on line 18.5 feet); thence with the Few's Bridge Road, S. 77-45 W. 208.6 feet to the beginning corner, and containing One acre (1) more or less.
