in the City of Greenville on the east side of Robins or Robinson Street known and designated as Lot #9, Block 2 of the sub-division bounded by streets heretofore known as Houstainia, Street, Louis Street and Plum Street and the C. & G. Railroad; said lot being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Robins or Robinson Street at corner of Lot #7 and running thence along line of lot #7 S. 87 E. 100 feet to iron pin at rear corner of lots #8 and #10; thence along line of lot #10 S. 12 W. 60 feet to iron pin; thence N. 78 W. 100 feet to iron pin on Robins or Robinson Street; thence along Robins or Robinson Street N. 12 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
