has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Margaret K. Baarcke, her heirs

and assigns:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2, Block "E", of the O. P. Mills Subdivision, and having, according to a plat thereof made by C. M. Furman, Jr., October 1930, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a point, the Northwestern intersection of Prentiss Avenue and Elm Street; thence with Elm Street N. 44-33 W. 180 feet to a point on South side of a 16-foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 45-27 W. 66 feet to a point; thence S. 44-33 E. 180 feet to a point on the Northwest side of Prentiss Avenue; thence with said Avenue N. 45-27 E. 66 feet to the point of beginning.
