Beginning at an iron pin, Southeast corner of Westfield Street and Johnson Street, and running thence with Westfield St. S. 21-23 W. 101.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Reeses Alley; thence with Reeses Alley S. 79-47 E. 162.7 feet to a R.
