ALL THAT CERTAIN piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot Number 7
of Block J of a subdivision known as Park Place, the plat of which is recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 119. Said lot has a frontage
on the West side of Second Avenue of 50 feet and runs back in parallel lines 150 feet to
a 10 foot alley.
