demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th  
day of September, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for  
the County aforesaid, to E. H. Edwards

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-9321)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid  
decree, and upon receipt of \$275.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said E. H. Edwards

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs  
Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being more fully described as  
follows:

BEGINNING at a point corner of Clarence Sexton's and McDavid's lands and running thence  
85 feet to corner of lands of McDavid and Littlefield; thence 96 feet to a point joining property  
of Frank Burnett and John Burnett; thence 85 feet to a point adjoining lands of John Burnett  
and Clarence Sexton; thence 96 feet to beginning corner. Said lot has a house thereon, and is  
the Northern portion of Lot of land conveyed to Frank Burnett and Nannie T. Moon, by deed  
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 71, Page 306 and is the same  
land conveyed to J. E. Hall by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated June 2, 1936, recorded in the
