TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Mrs. Camie Bowling, her heirs and assigns forever, for cemetery purposes, with the understanding that the said Mrs. Camie Bowling shall conform with all reasonable regulations which may be made by the said Holiness Baptist Church concerning the management and conduct of its own cemetery.
