(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Lizzie K. Shockley her heirs and assigns;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
known and designated as tract No. 2 of the property of C. F. Putman, formerly known as the W. S.
Moore Farm, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle,
Surveyor, January, 1927.

Beginning at an iron pin in the Simpsonville or Log Shoal Road, at the southwestern
corner of tract No. 3, and in line of tract No. 1, and running thence with line of tract No. 1,
N. 55-15 W. 285 feet; thence N. 74-15 W. 320 feet; thence still with said Simpsonville Road N.
83 W. 1072 feet to a stake; thence N. 19-45 W. 125 feet to a stake; thence N. 49-45 W. 116 feet
to a poplar; thence N. 19 1/2 W. 184 feet to a stake on Hendrix line; thence N. 67 E. 103 feet to
a stone; thence N. 60-20 E. 510 feet to a stone; thence with line of Todd property N. 54-50 E.
1687 feet to a stone; thence N. 88-15 E. 462 feet to a stake, corner of Griffin property; thence
with Griffin line N. 50-30 E. 1145 feet to a stake; thence S. 74-30 W. 1140 feet to a stake in
settlement road; thence S. 42-30 W. 268 feet to a stake; thence S. 10 W. 792 feet to the beginning
corner, containing 67.20 acres, more or less. This being the same land conveyed to me by deed
of T. L. Putman dated Nov. 18th, 1932 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County
in Vol. 175 page 490.

Also all that piece, parcel or tract of lands situate, lying and being in said
County and state in Fairview Township and adjoining the above described tract, and being a part
of a tract containing 75.09 acres known as tract No. 4, in the decision of the home place in the
estate of E. F. Griffin deceased, and described by courses and distances as follows:

BEGINNING at a maple on the branch joint corner of tracts 3 and 4 this being the
corner of a 50 acre tract sold by me to N. I. Kay and running thence along the line of N. I. Kay
S. 62-15 E. 15.98 to a stake thence N. 50-30 W. along the line of the property herein before
described. 15.66 to a stone; thence N. 73-30 E. 31.00 to a maple at branch, thence down the
meanderings of said branch as the line to the beginning point and containing 25.09 acres more
or less and being a part and all of the remainder which I now own of the same tract of land
conveyed to me by J. C. Griffin, et al by their deed dated Oct. 20, 1930 and recorded in office of
R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 157 page 132.
