I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Albert C. Gossett, as Administrator C. T. A., and T. Smith

on or about the 17th day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-two exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Albert C. Gossett, Jr. and Myrtle Gossett,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 23rd day of September, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to T. Smith and Etta Smith

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-9337)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$450.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said T. Smith and Etta Smith

"All that certain parcel and lot of land in Dunklin Township, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by W. A. Gossett on the North and West, and by other lands now or formerly belonging to J. C. Gossett on the East and South, and containing 11 1/4 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone, and running thence N. 8 W. 6.30 to a stone; thence S. 76 1/2 W. 21.93 to a stone in the branch; thence S. 20 1/2 E. 2.12 to stone; thence N. 89 1/2 E. 22.76 to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. C. Gossett by J. E. Gossett, et al, on November 15, 1926, and recorded in Vol. 141, at page 560, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County."
