All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda \_\_\_\_\_ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Known as the same land conveyed to me by deed from John C. Agnew, August 19th, 1941, and recorded in Vol. 236, page 184, Beginning at a stone o.m. Harts and Johnsons corner thence running N. 36 1/2 E. 9.50 chs. to a stone o.m. thence N. 50 E. 16.15 chs. to a stake thence N. 24 W. 11.90 chs. to a point in the Marietta Road thence with said Road S. 72 W. 4.50 chs. to a bend in said road; thence 89 1/2 W. 6.88 chs. to a corner in said road thence S. 5 W. 27.40 to the beginning corner and contains 26 1/2 acres, more or less.

Also all that piece, parcel and lot of land lying situate and being in Saluda Township, State and County aforesaid, known as the same land conveyed to me by deed from E. L. Cox January 3rd, day 1939. Recorded in Vol. 208, page 26, adjoining lands of myself Luther Harris and Elbert Bruce Beginning on a stone in road thence with said road N. 53 1/2 W. 2.15 chs. to a bend in road thence N. 72 1/2 W. 1.00 to i. p. thence S. 22 W. 3.00 chs. to i. p. thence S. 78 E. 3.50 to a pine tree and contains 9/10 of an acre more or less.

Also all that other piece parcel and lot of land lying situate and being in Saluda Township State of South Carolina, Greenville County, known as the same land conveyed to me by deed from E. L. Cox, July 10, 1937, recorded in Vol. 197, page 215, Greenville, S. C. adjoin lands of myself Buford Bridges and D. F. Reynolds.

Beginning on an i. p. Reynolds corner and thence N. 31 E. 1.27 chs. to an i. p. in a Settlement Road; thence with said road 2.66 chs. to an i. p.
