All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Scuffletown Road (sometimes referred to as the Woodruff Road), in Butler Township, Greenville County, S. C., bounded on the South by property of T. P. Brown, on the East by property of J. C. Howell, on the West by County Road and other property of the grantor, and on the North by the Scuffletown Road and containing 9.19 acres, more or less, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March 6, 1936, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in center of Scuffletown Road on Culvert in branch at corner of property of J. C. Howell and running thence along the Scuffletown Road N. 82-45 W. 720 feet to a stake in said Scuffletown Road; thence continuing with Scuffletown Road, N. 83-30 W. 231 feet to a point in the center of the intersection of Scuffletown Road with the road leading South therefrom to and through the property of T. P. Brown; thence along said last mentioned road, S. 14-42 E. 341.5 feet to a point; thence continuing with said road leading toward T. P. Brown's property S. 15-00 E. 418.6 feet to a point in center of said road in line of property of T. P. Brown; thence with said Brown line, N. 62-0 E. 739 feet to a point in center of branch in line of J. C. Howell property; thence with the center of said branch and following the meanderings thereof N. 26-0 E. 295 feet to a point on Culvert over branch in center of Scuffletown Road, the beginning corner.
