QUIT-CLAIM DEED.

WHEREAS, heretofore, to wit, on or about May 20th, 1942, the Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc., and the United States of America entered into a contract whereby the Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc., agreed to release all of its interest in its right-of-way which ran across the lands to be used by the Greenville Army Air Base, provided the United States of America would remove all of the telephone facilities located along the right-of-way across the Air Base property. The United States has performed its part of the contract in that it has removed all of the poles and telephone facilities from the Augusta Road Telephone Company's right-of-way, and has re-located the same to the satisfaction of the Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc., in accordance with the attached drawing titled "Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc., Relocating Around Air Base", File No. G-55-3, which is made a part of this quit-claim deed,

THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, the Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc. does hereby relinquish, surrender, transfer, release, and quit-claim to the United States of America, and its assigns, all its rights, title and interest in and to certain property which the Augusta Road Telephone Company, Inc., holds under grants of right-of-way, easements or other evidence of title lying within the Air Base.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said United States of America and its assigns forever.
