containing 150 acres more or less, bounded by the North Carolina line separating it from the lands of Angeline Ward, on the east by lands of Harriet Gosnell, on the southeast by lands of Perry Davis, on south by lands of John Gordan, on southwest by lands of Erple Pace, and J. M. Bell on the west by lands of Levi Ward, less, however a tract containg 20 acres, more or less, along the southern boundary of this 150 acre tract in which the grantees herein have this day conveyed all their right, title and interest to the grantors, reference to which deed is made for a particular description of said land.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to to grantors and grantees herein by Frank L. Hill and Ethel Hill by deed of record in deed book 229 at page 140, R. M. C. records for Greenville County, and is also shown as containg 197.6 acres on plat made by G. W. Justice in November, 1936, reference to which deed and plat is craved for a more complete description of this land.

The consideration for this deed is division of undivided interest in the above land, cross deeds having been made by the parties in interest.
