POWER OF ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, I, William Henry Jarrard, am about to enter the Armed Forces of my Country and desire to give to my father, P. D. Jarrard, full power and authority to manage all of my affairs and carry on my business as fully as I might do if present.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, William Henry Jarrard, do hereby constitute and appoint P. D. Jarrard, of Greenville County, South Carolina, as my true and lawful attorney, for me, and in my name and stead, to manage and control all property now or hereafter owned by me in Greenville County, South Carolina, and, without excluding other powers, specifically including the following:

1. The power to receive and collect all debts, monies, goods and all other demands whatsoever, which are, or shall be due and payable to me or detained from me whatsoever, and to institute any legal proceeding in my name and stead and to execute any instruments necessary for that purpose.

2. To improve, lease, rent, sell and convey by fee simple warranty deed or otherwise, at whatever prices and upon whatever terms he deems best in his absolute discretion, any of my said property and to reinvest the proceeds thereof in any investment he deems wise without regard to whether or not such investments are such as are denominated legal investments for fiduciaries.

3. To borrow money and execute as security therefor notes, mortgages or other necessary or expedient credit instruments.

4. To do all things necessary to carry on the business of P. D. Jarrard and Son, and in my name and stead, to execute any notes, bills, obligations, mortgages or other security instruments for the purpose of carrying on said business so as to bind any or all of my property, whether as part of the partnership assets or not.

And generally to do all things and acts in my name and stead necessary or expedient in the management of my affairs as fully as I myself would do if present.
