All that certain lot of land on Briar and Springer Streets in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as Lot No. 14 of subdivision of Carson property as shown on Brunson survey according to plat recorded in Plat Book E at page 61 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, said lot according to said plat being bounded on the East 240 feet by Choice land (on which is now located Sistine Stadium), on the North 86 feet by a 20-foot street, on the West 200 feet by a 20-foot street (now known as Briar Street) and on the South 42 feet by a 30-foot Street (now known as Springer Street) and containing one-third of an acre, more or less. This is one of the lots conveyed to H. J. Haynsworth by P. D. Gilreath, Sheriff (and not recorded) under execution for taxes against P. W. B. Freeman (the other of the lots so conveyed to H. J. Haynsworth having been conveyed by him to C. F. Dill by deed dated April 10, 1897 and recorded in Deed Book CCC at page 742) and conveyed to Freeman by W. D. Mayfield and W. M.
