All that piece, parcel or lot of land in OnealTownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

near Double Springs Baptist Church, on the north side of the Road leading from Double Springs Church to Milford Church, and being a part of the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed from my father, W. S. Dill, about the year 1938 and which was conveyed to W. S. Dill by deed from W. A. Clark Feb. 21st, 1936, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 180 at page 498, and having the following courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning on an iron pin in old stump, on North side of above named Road, and being the corner of Mrs. Alma S. Collins, and runs thence with the Collins line N. 21-21 W. 702.8 feet to a stone, old corner; thence S. 77-45 W. 156 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 1-10 W. 398.5 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of a 1/2 ac lot, being conveyed this day to C. J. Collins, thence with the line of the 1/2 acre lot, N. 89-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the 1/2 acre lot S. 1-10 W. 218 feet to a point in the above named Road (iron pin on North bank of said road); thence with the said road N. 87-10 E. 317.7 feet to the beginning corner, and containing three and 50/100 (3.50) acres, more or less.

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
