near Double Springs Baptist Church, on the North side of the Road that leads from Double Springs Church to Milford Church, and being a part of the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed from my father, W. S. Dill, about the year 1938, and part of the same tract that was conveyed to W. S. Dill by deed from W. A. Clark, Feb. 21st, 1936, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 180 at page 498, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the above named road, and being the joint corner of another tract being conveyed this day to Alma S. Collins, and runs thence with the line of the Ama S. Collins tract N. 1-10 E. 218 feet to an iron pin, corner of the Alma S. Collins tract; thence continuing with the Alma S. Collins tract S. 89-30 W. 100 to an iron pin, joint corner of the Alma S. Collins tract; thence S. 1-10 W. 218 feet to a point in the above named road (iron pin on north bank of said road); thence with the said road N. 87-10 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner and containing one half (0.50) acre, more or less.
