

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John C. Henry, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) DOLLARS

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Simmons,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. D. Simmons, his heirs and assigns forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and in Graceland Cemetery, and known and designated as Lot Number Two Hundred Thirty Three (No. 233) in Section Eighty (8), containing Two Hundred (200) square feet, more or less, the same being described and designated as above in according with Map on file in the Office of Greenville Cemetery Association, a corporation of South Carolina.

It is understood that said lot of land is to be used only for the purposes stated in a certain deed made to me by said Greenville Cemetery Association on July 28, 1919, recorded in Vol. 29 at page 372, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and subject to all restrictions and limitations set forth in said Deed and with benefit of all covenants therein.
