Know all men by these presents that I, L. O. Patterson, of the County of Greenville, in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), and for other valuable consideration, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Wylie Shumate all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said state and county, about a hundred yards southwest of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the northwest side of Minus Street, on the east corner of Lot No. 13 of Block "D" of "Sterling Annex," as shown in Plat Book "C", page 81, in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for said county (being the same lot conveyed by Home Owners' Loan Corporation to Azalee and Elliott Johnson by deed recorded in Book 209, page 452), and running thence along said street N. 43-20 E. one-half the distance between the said beginning point and the south corner of Lot No. 7 of "Enoree Annex", as shown on W. D. Neves's plat recorded in said office in Plat Book "F", on plage 156; thence approximately N. 28-30 W. 200 feet, more or less, along line of Lot this day conveyed by me to Clyde Shumate, to a stake on Lot No. 1 on said "Enoree Annex" plat, half way between the northwest corner of Lot No. 7 and the northwest corner of Lot No. 9 on said last mentioned plat; thence S. 56-45 W. 26.2 feet, more or less, with line of Lot No. 1, to a stake on line of the H. K. Townes land; thence in a general southeasterly direction, with lines of the said Townes land and Johnson lot, 215 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner; this being a portion of the land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated April 8, 1918, and and recorded in said office in Book 40, page 66. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
