do hereby acknowledge payment to me by Brandon Corporation of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, in full settlement for all injury and damage of every kind, past present, and future, to said land on account of, or growing out of the maintenance and operation by Brandon Corporation of sewage and waste disposal plants at or near its industrial plant known as Renfrew Plant near Travelers Rest, and the discharge of sewerage and waste disposal by said Brandon Corporation in the Reedy River, which runs through my land, and I hereby give said Brandon Corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to empty its sewerage and waste disposal from its plants into the Reedy River or its tributary streams above my said land.
