POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Ernest Belton Sizemore, have constituted, made and appointed, and by these presents do constitute, make and appoint my wife, Sarah Langford Sizemore, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead, and to use, to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sum of sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, and other demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing or payable to me or detained from me or from her as my true and lawful attorney in any manner or ways or means whatsoever, and I furthermore authorize and appoint the said Sarah Langford Sizemore for me, and in my name, to offer for sale, bargain, sell and convey any land which I might own or possess and for me and in my name, to execute all necessary papers, to convey to the purchaser, whoever he, she, or they may be, a good and sufficient warranty title in fee simple to the same;

GIVING AND GRANTING unto Sarah Langford Sizemore, my said attorney, by these presents full and whole power, strength and authority, in and about the premises to have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery of any moneys due me and for the execution of any necessary conveyances and upon the receipt of any such debts, dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquittances or other sufficient discharges for me and in my name to make, seal and deliver; and generally all and every other act and acts, thing and things, devise and devises in law whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises, for me and in my name to do, execute and perform, as fully, largely and amply to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do, were I personally present, ratifying, allowing and holding, for firm and effectual, all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the premises, by virtue hereof.
