POWER--OF--ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I, Thomas Parker, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these present do make, constitute and appoint the South Carolina National Bank of Charles, South Carolina, Greenville Branch, my true and lawful attorney to sell and convey my land and appurtenances, or any parcel or parcels thereof, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at such prices as seem to it advisable.

Upon receipt of the consideration or purchase price for the same or any part thereof my said attorney is authorized to give a good receipt therefor, which receipt shall exonerate the person paying such money from seeing to the application thereof or of being responsible for the loss or misapplication thereof.

My said attorney is authorized to sign and seal as my act and deed any instrument in writing and to do every other thing necessary or proper for carrying into effect and execution any agreement of sale made by it in such manner that all my right title estate or interest in or to the land and appurtenances included in such agreement of sale, so that the same may be effectually and absolutely conveyed and assured to the purchaser or the respective purchasers thereof, his and their heirs and assigns forever, or unto such other person or persons and for such other estate or estates therein and in such manner and form as he or they shall direct or appoint.

I do further authorize my said attorney, the South Carolina National Bank of Greenville Branch, upon the sale of any lot or lots by it made, to accept as little cash as it may deem advisable and to accept in my name a mortgage securing the balance of the purchase price.

And I do further authorize my said attorney, the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, South Carolina, Greenville Branch, to receive the principal and interest due on any notes secured by mortgages accepted by it under the powers given above and on receipt of the said principal, interest and costs to release the said mortgage and to acknowledge and enter a satisfaction on said mortgage given and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises; hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said attorney shall do therein by virtue of these presents.

And I do further authorize my said attorney, the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, South Carolina, Greenville Branch, to endorse any stock certificate that I may own and to sell the same at such price or prices as seem to it advisable and to invest the proceeds in
