- (4) That the grantor reserves to itself and its successors the right to authorize the placing, maintaining and repairing of any and all public utilities in the streets without compensation to any lot owner.
- (5) That no surface closet nor cess pool shall ever be maintained on said land, but only septic tanks or other sanitary sewerage.
- (6) That no use shall be made of said lot which would constitute a nuisance to the adjoining lot owner.
