All that piece, parcel or lot of land in.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All those certain two lots of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and better known and designated as Lot No. "6" and the southern portion of 25 feet of Lot No. "5", in Section "A" of the property of H. H. Willis and Alice M. Willis, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November, 1939 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, South Carolina in Plat "J" at pages 150 and 151 to which said plat and the record thereof reference is hereby made. And being more particularly described with meets and bounds and distances as follows:

Beginning: At a point which is an iron pin, on the corners of Lot No. "7" & "6" facing on Clemson Avenue and running thence in a Northerly direction 125 feet to an iron pin corner of Alice Avenue and Clemson Avenue and running thence in a Easternly direction along the lines of said Alice Avenue to a point and an iron pin 269.1 feet, more or less, thence in a Southernly direction 128 feet to an iron pin rear corners of Lot "6" & "7", thence in a Westernly direction according to plat 294 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the beginning corner, and being identically the property above described as Lot No. "6" and 25 feet of Lot No. "5" as shown by per plat above referred to.

This property is sold subject to the following restrictions to wit:
First: This property shall be used for residential purposes only unless the grantee herein chooses to use said property for business purposes.
Second: This property shall be used owned and occupied by persons of the white race for a period of ninety-nine years from this date, no persons having any negro blood, firms, individuals or cooperations shall ever have the grant of use to this property, for a period of ninety-nine years from this date.
Third: This property is sold subject to any easements, right-of-ways, that may now be recorded against this property (see record, Greenville County, S. C.)
