(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Louie B. Lister and Frances Lister, their Heirs and Assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 42 on plat of North Sunset Hills, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive at joint front corner of Lots No. 41 and 42, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 41, N. 38-17 W. 164 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 43-22 E. 62 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots No. 42 and 43; thence with the line of Lot No. 43, S. 37-52 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive; thence with the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive, S. 53-58 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is made subject to the restrictive covenants which are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 237, at page 101.

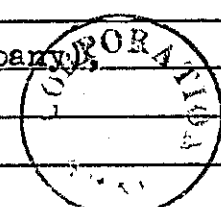
