WHEREAS, C. M. Gaffney, 14 West McBee Ave., Greenville, S. C.
C. M. Gaffney, Jr., Liberty Life Building, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 10th day of July, 1943, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is C. M. GAFFNEY SALES AGENCY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 14 West McBee Av., Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to act as agent for persons, firms or corporations owning cemetery or memorial park property; to develop, manage, superintend, buy and sell cemetery or memorial park property, lots, crypts in mansoleums, and urns for cremated remains therein, as agent, on commission, or otherwise; to contract for, buy and sell as agent, on commission or otherwise, grave markers and other ornaments and incidental devices, articles and objects commonly used in commemorating the resting place of the dead; to buy, sell, rent, trade, exchange, lease, develop, improve, manage, superintend, mortgage and otherwise encumber, other real estate, as agent or otherwise; and to transact all or any other business which may be necessary or proper or incidental to the exercise of any or all of the aforesaid purposes of the corporation.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, payable in cash or services.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ten (10) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 30th day of July, 1943, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: C. M. Gaffney and C. M. Gaffney, Jr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President C. M. Gaffney as Vice-President, C. M. Gaffney, Jr.; as Secretary, C. M. Gaffney, Jr. as Treasurer, C. M. Gaffney.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
