Landrum J. Vaughn

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, about two and one half miles West of the Town of Greer, adjoining lands of Landrum J. Vaughn, R. B. Vaughn and the Fairview Baptist Church Cemetery, and being a part of the same land conveyed to the Deacons of Fairview Baptist Church by deed from R. B. Vaughn March 22nd, 1904 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 000 at page 148 and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on a stake (Pine gone) old corner of the cemetery grounds and corner of Landrum J. Vaughn's land, and runs thence with the line of Landrum J. Vaughn S. 34-50 E. 35 feet to a stake on the original line of the Cemetery property and Landrum J. Vaughn; thence with the Western edge of the Drive Way of the Cemetery N. 33-51 E. 91.36 feet to a stake on the original line of the cemetery property; thence with the original line of the cemetery property S. 56-10 W. 85.82 feet to the beginning corner.
