demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 5th  
day of May, 1943, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for  
the County aforesaid, to Mrs. L. C. Neloms

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-9577)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid  
decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Mrs. L. C. Neloms

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land on the east side of North Saluda River, in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, according to plat made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, January 15, 1943, to-wit:  
Beginning at a Sycamore tree on the east side of the Saluda River, and running thence S. 46 E. 19.56 chains to a sweet gum on branch; thence down said branch as a line, N. 10 E. 22.50 chains to creek; thence with the creek as a line, N. 68 W. 7.12 chains to the North Saluda River; thence down said river as a line, 15.38 chains to the beginning corner and containing 22 1/2 acres, more or less, and being the same tract as conveyed to Jesse Young by deed of C. A. Hodges and Oscar Hodges, dated January 17, 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 97, page 322".

The consideration for the above conveyance is \$800.00. The sum of \$400.00 was paid in cash to the Master and a note and mortgage for \$400.00 was given to Mrs. Anita Young and to Roy Young to secure their interest in said purchase price. This was in accordance with the Decree of Court in the above entitled action.
