(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Jessie L. Grumbles and her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. fourteen (14) and fifteen (15), as shown on a plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 190, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point on the East side of Waco Street, said point being 120 feet from the right-of-way of the Greenville, Spartanburg and Anderson Railway industrial siding, and running thence with said Street S. 75-02 W. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-3/4 E. 146.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 75-02 E. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-3/4 W. 146.5 feet to the point of beginning on Waco Street. Being the same lots as conveyed by Brandon Mills to W. T. Hudson and L. A. Hudson on December 16, 1914, deed recorded in deed book 12 at page 570, said W. T. Hudson having conveyed his interest in said lots to said L. A. Hudson, his wife, by deed dated December 20, 1923, recorded in deed book 91 at page 52, we being the sole heirs at law and distributees of the said L. A. (Lucy A.) Hudson, deceased.

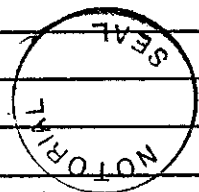
