H. F. Williams and Eunice G. Williams.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
on the southwest side of Sylvania Avenue just off Paris Mountain Road and being known as Lot #47  
of a subdivision known as Leawood, property of C. M. Gaffney, Trustee, according to a Plat of  
Record in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book J at pages 18 and 19, and having  
the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest intersection of Sylvania Avenue and Forest Lane and  
running thence with Forest Lane S. 33-54 W. 166.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55-41 W. 75 feet;  
thence N. 33-54 E. 165.5 feet to an iron pin on Sylvania Avenue; thence with Sylvania Avenue S.  
56-06 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
