All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being located on the east side of the old Greenville-Laurens Road in the Town of Simpsonville, bounded by lands this day being conveyed to grantees by Mrs. Maggie Thackston, et al. the spur tract of the C. & W. C. Railway running to the Mill Village, lands of Casper Griffin, et al. with metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning in the center of the Old Stage Road (Greenville-Laurens Road) at a point -- grantees' corner-- and running thence, along their line, N. 67 E. 229 feet to an iron pin; thence, N. 2-15 E. 74 feet to an iron pin on the spur railroad track; thence along said track N. 88.35 E. 218 feet to bend; thence, continuing along said spur track N. 80-25 E. 82 feet to an iron pin; thence, S. 3-05 E. 94.5 feet to a point in the gully; thence, gully the line S. 69-15 W. 149.8 feet to bend; thence, continuing-- gully the line-- S. 52-30 W. 434 feet to point in the center of said road; thence, up the center of said road N. 6 W. 246 feet to the beginning corner-- said metes and bounds being in accord with plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, October 23, 1941 and being the identical tract of land conveyed to grantor by X T. O. Thackston by deed dated November 7, 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C.
