containing 90.56 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, as shown on  
plat prepared by J. H. Atkins, Surveyor, for T. A. Hyder, dated, July 30, 1943, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Emory's Creek at corner of lands of Lonny Penfield and Tom West  
and running thence along line of lands of said Tom West S 76-23 W 391 feet to a stone at corner  
of Carpenter's land; thence along line of said Carpenter's lands 29-00 E 1434 feet to a stake  
in an old road; thence N 49-30 E 457 feet to a stake on Emory's Creek; thence down Emory's Creek  
as the line 650 feet, more or less, to a stake at the corner of C. S. West's land; thence along  
line of West's land N 12-20 W 268 feet to an iron pin near the edge of a road; thence N 33-20 E  
1052 feet to a white flint; thence N 50 E 198 feet to a point in Rutherford Road; thence along  
said road N 15-00 E 462 feet to a point in said road; thence continuing along said road N 16-30  
E 533 feet to a stake in old road; thence S 87 1/2 E 80 feet to a stake; thence N 2-2 E 195 feet to  
an iron pin; thence crossing Rutherford Road and another road N 87-15 W. 1814 feet to a stone  
at corner of lands of Bart Tallant Estate and Lonny Penfield; thence along line of lands of Lonny  
Penfield S 7-10 E 501.5 feet to a stone pile; thence S 24-30 W 660 feet to a stake; thence S  
57-30 W. 325.5 feet to the beginning corner.
